Valleria Janes Cook Scholarship

Women's Club at UIUC is proud to honor major donors Harry and Valleria Cook. Valleria, also known as Val and Valle, was President of Women's Club from 1994-95. Among other positions she served as Scholarship Chair, and she was very proactive on behalf of the scholarship initiative. Working with a number of other members, she chaired a benefit event to launch the Women's Club scholarship endowment at the U of I Foundation.

In another initiative, Val worked to create a set of four decorative University of Illinois tiles, starting with the Morrow Plot Commemorative Tile, which were sold for the benefit of our scholarship program. She served as the designer, project coordinator, sales representative, and warehouser for this project, which enhanced our funds and provided many members and friends with lovely tiles.

Valleria coordinated another important fundraiser in pursuit of the same goal. She led the Antiques and Collectibles Group in what is now an annual tradition--an auction for the benefit of the scholarship fund, raising thousands of dollars over the years.

In the Spring of 2004, Valleria and Harry Cook moved to Breckenridge, Colorado. Before they left the community, they generously announced that they wished to donate a scholarship in Val's name through the Women's Club. Their strong feelings about scholarships for UIUC students are based on numerous connections. Not only had Harry been a professor at this university for many years, retiring as Head of the General Engineering Department, but a number of family members are University of Illinois alumni. Because of their understanding of the primary importance of higher education, their ties to this university, and Valleria's history with the Women's Club, they have chosen to fund the Valleria Janes Cook Scholarship at the Women's Club. We are greatly honored and thank them for their generosity.

We also thank a former scholarship recipient who looked back gratefully at her Women's Club grant and returned the favor with a generous donation to our fund. And of course, we appreciate every member who makes a donation. When you meet the recipients of the 2004-2005 Women's Club scholarships at the February Brunch, you should be very proud of all the Club's efforts. Further contributions are always welcome and will be allocated to grants in the following academic year.
