

Madagascar: Heads it's a Continent, Tails it's an Island

Featured Speaker is Susan Kieffer CAS and Walgreen Professor of Geology and Physics

Madagascar is the fourth largest island in the world, and lies only 250 miles off the east coast of Africa. It is a land of tragic poverty and massive deforestation, of gentle people whose language descended from far-away Indonesia (not Africa), and a land where some of the most exotic species of animals in the world reside. Join us for a tour through some of the cities, jungles, and deserts of Madagascar; hear the cries of the mysterious Indri lemurs ringing through the jungle canopy, and laugh with Sue as she recounts how she and three colleagues spent a few hours in the custody of the federal gendarmes on Christmas night, 2007!

Susan Kieffer is a planetary scientist by training, and has worked on problems of volcanic eruptions and meteorite impacts on a number of planets and satellites. Much of her work, however, has been on earth—at Mount St. Helens during the 1980 eruptions, in the Grand Canyon studying the hydraulics of the major rapids, and at Meteor Crater, Arizona, studying the effects of the impact on the rocks that were shattered about 50,000 years ago. Over the past decade, her interests have turned toward sustainability issues, and the purpose of the Madagascar trip was partly to study the effects of deforestation on the land, people and fauna.


