

This year's annual Scholarship Awards Brunch was held at the Illini Union on March 1, 2014. Our guest speaker, Chancellor Phyllis Wise, thanked Club members for their generous scholarship contributions that help deserving students afford an Illinois education. She also thanked the students for their contributions to campus and encouraged them to keep working hard. It was truly a stirring talk. Following the Chancellor's remarks, the thirteen students, selected from over 235 applicants, inspired and awed us with their accomplishments, their passion, and their plans for the future. Following the brunch, the Chancellor and attendees mingled and took pictures.

The Illinois Club was excited to be able to award over \$28,000 in student scholarships this year. We also gave out a new award in 2014, the STEM Education award. This award was initiated because one of our members, Michael Haney, wanted to recognize and encourage educators who were pursuing teaching in STEM fields as opposed to careers in industry. For those wishing to teach high school science, it takes 10 semesters (or an extra year) for them to receive their teaching degree, which is an additional disincentive to become an educator.

In addition, we designated one of our Make-A-Difference scholarships as a Mary Jo Thomsen award, to recognize our former President and Treasurer who passed away unexpectedly a few months ago. Mary Jo and her husband were active members of our military until their retirement, and she was an avid scholarship donor and passionate about education.

Judith Life Ikenberry Fine Arts Award

Johnivan Darby is a New Media major originally from Evergreen Park, IL. He is a junior and a member of The National Society of Collegiate Scholars, the Idea Coordinator for the ILC Student Leadership Advisory Team, and a freelance graphic designer.
