This special exhibit features glass works by Dale Chihuly and other artists including Lino Tagliapietra and Vittorio Constantini. Following the tour, we will have free time to revisit the exhibit or explore the Peoria Riverfront Museum's other exhibits, art collections, and planetarium. Our time at the museum will be followed by self-hosted lunch at a local Peoria restaurant within a block of the museum.

Herff-Jones Collegiate Cap and Gown Tour

On January 24th twenty-three members explored the behind the scenes work of this important business that makes graduations, church services, and other "cap and gown" events memorable. Champaign's plant covers 320,000 square feet and encompasses 27 buildings. The variety of styles, colors and purposes as well as the numerous detail designs keep the 300 or so staff members busy. This employee-owned company has a 4-6 week entry level training program. If applicants are hired it is possible to work up to more complex level tasks. Employees come from 14 different countries, many from Asia with Americans making up one fourth of the workforce. This tour promoted lively discussion for the lunch attendees. Caps and gowns produced here help greatly to add great distinction to the event or occupation they represent.
