with several events and exhibits in a cross-campus initiative. As part of this initiative, the Sousa Archives and Center for American Music will be hosting exhibits that display how music supported the war effort. On our tour we will visit the archives. The very enthusiastic and knowledgeable guide for our visit will be the Archivist and Director of the Sousa Archives, Scott Schwartz. We will conclude our tour with a World War I themed cocktail hour at Houlihan's featuring two traditional World War I cocktails: the Sidecar and the French 75.
