## Lincoln's Trials and Tribulations Dinner Theater – 1847 Matson Slave Trial and Coles County Lincoln Events

### Saturday, September 24 Dinner Theater 6:00 - 8:00 PM, Oakland, IL Times and locations vary for other Coles County Lincoln events

It's time to sign up for the September 24<sup>th</sup> tour to Oakland, IL to experience the Lincoln's Trial and Tribulations Dinner Theater dramatizing the 1847 Matson Slave Trial. The dinner theater event happens only four times a year and sells out quickly. Coles County organizes many other events on those days to give you the opportunity to learn more about Abraham Lincoln. Coles County in East Central Illinois is less than an hour away.

You have many options for this tour. You can choose to join us for only the dinner theater from 6-8 pm at \$30 per person, join us for just the free Lincoln events [see https://sites.google.com/site/linkontolincoln/schedule] earlier in the day, or join us for both. This is an event for singles, couples, guests, and families. The dinner theater is appropriate for those in middle school and up. The deadline to register for the dinner theater is September 12.
