Join us for a tour of the C.H. Moore Homestead and the Timberview Alpaca Farm. We will plan to have lunch in between visiting the homestead and farm. Watch your E News for more details coming soon.



**C.H. Moore Homestead** is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. This restored mansion and grounds takes visitors back to the Victorian era. Once home to Clinton attorney Clifton H. Moore, visitors will enjoy tours and stories of the friend and law partner of Abraham Lincoln who once resided there. It is also the home of the DeWitt County Museum.

**Timberview Alpaca Farm**, established in 2010, is a small family-run farm. Learn about alpacas, pet and feed them, view a felting demo, and visit the farm store.
