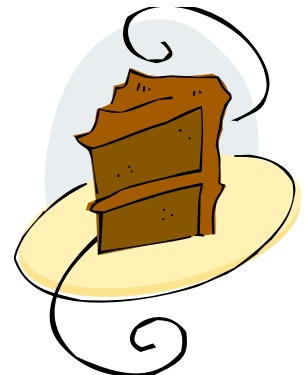

ITINERARY FOR SPRING BUS TRIP TO ST. LOUIS

*****KEEP THIS!*****

- 1 Board bus at 6:45 AM at the Assembly Hall Parking lot E 14, corner of First St. and St. Mary's Rd. It is a Monticello bus. Arrive home about 8 PM.
- 2 Morning spent at the St. Louis Art Museum in Forest Park. The special exhibit "Art in Bloom" invited Floral Designers to express the spirit of a work of art through a floral design. The works of art are located throughout the Museum. This program is similar to, but on a much larger scale than, the "Petals and Paintings" event in C-U on Moms' Day Weekend. Guided tours are offered every half hour, or you may browse on your own. Two other special exhibits: "Jeweled Arts of India" and "Painted Prints." This exceptionally beautiful museum represents many cultures, time periods, subjects, and artistic media.

Lunch on your own in the Museum dining room ordering from the menu. Dining room opens at 11 AM. We are requested to try to enter by 11:30 AM. **WE WILL LEAVE THE MUSEUM AROUND 1 PM.**

- 3 At this time you will have a choice to make. Next 3 hrs may be spent at Missouri Botanical Gardens, or the Cherokee Street Antique Row, or stay in Forest Park and Museum til 3:45 PM.

The first drop-off is the Gardens (small entrance fee). There are 79 acres including Climatron Rainforest Conservatory, the Kemper Center for Home Gardening, a Japanese Garden, a Chinese Garden, Tower Grove House, English Woodland Garden, sculptures, a maze, and more. Pickup at the Gardens is 4:30 PM.

The other drop-off is at Cherokee Street Antique Row (West end). Antique Row is 7 blocks of about 30 shops, historic homes, and quaint eateries. You will be given maps to do your own walking tour along the way. Benches provided. 5 PM pickup is at the East end of Cherokee at the Lemp Mansion where you may view the "historic haunted house" or eat.

- 4 We hope to be on the road home at about 5 PM. We will NOT stop for dinner. Snacks, drinks, and fruit will be served on the bus. In the morning we will serve juice and a breakfast sweet. If you bring your own coffee, we suggest you use a cup with a lid.

Please keep this sheet, it is your only notice. **The fee is \$32.00** which includes bus, food, and misc. expenses. If there are fewer than 40 people, we may need to collect a few more dollars from you on the bus. Early sign-up is appreciated. Let us know on the enclosed form which of the afternoon options you will do. You can change your mind, but a general idea will help us plan. Make your check out to Women's Club at UIUC. Questions? 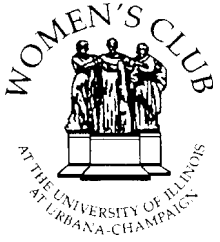
