Join us on November 4 for a campus tour to learn more about UI resources for those with disabilities. First we will visit **The Autism Program (TAP)**, located inside the Family Resiliency Center in Doris Kelley Christopher Hall. We will then walk next door to the new **Chez Family Foundation Center for Wounded Veterans in Higher Education**. The first location specializes in resources for those with developmental disabilities and the second for those with physical disabilities; both have resources for mental illness. After the tour there will be an opportunity to join others for a no-host dinner at the **Intermezzo Café**, located just a short walk away inside the Krannert Center for Performing Arts.

This FREE tour will be on Friday, November 4, 2016, beginning at 3:15 pm at 906 West Nevada Street, Urbana, on the northwest corner of Nevada and Lincoln. We will walk next door to 908 West Nevada Street to begin the next tour at 4:15 pm. The tours will end about 5 pm. There is metered parking in the lot west of the Wounded Veterans building and on the street. For those who use public transportation, the Red MTD bus serves this area.
